When jockey Eddie Arcaro galloped across the finish line astride Citation in the 1948 Kentucky Derby, he broke a long-standing record set by Isaac "Ike" Murphy.

Murphy, a Negro, was one of racing's all-time greats and the first jockey to win the Churchill Downs classic three times. The record stood for 57 years, until Arcaro toppled it by winning his fourth on Citation.



JACOB DODSON

Famed explorer John C. Fremont surrounded himself with able men on his expeditions to the Far West. One of them was named Kit Carson. Another was Jacob Dodson.

Dodson joined Fremont when he was 18 and accompanied him on three expeditions into the wilderness west of the Rockies.

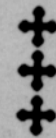
AMBULATORY SURGERY SERVICE

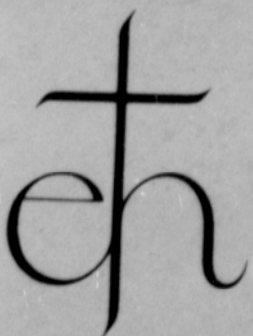
