Participates in classroom and on-the-job training to gain the knowledges and skills needed for full performance Police Communications Operator (PCO) work. After a 6 mos. training program, the Trainee will be eligible for appointment as a PCO. A full performance PCO takes calls for police services from citizens and police units; operates computer terminals, determines priority of calls, maintains availability status for police field units, retrieves police records information from computerized data banks; routes calls for police service and transmits to field units using radio, telephone or teletype, and prepares police reports on some incidents.
