Notice is hereby given that the City of Milwaukie, Clackamas County Oregon, will receive sealed bids for the construction of an overflow drainage line for the proposed 2 million gallon storage reservoir.

The construction site for this project is in the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, just southerly from the intersection of Stanley Avenue and Harlow Street.

Bids for the overflow drainage line will be received at the office of the Public Works Director, City Hall, 10722 S.E. Main Street, Milwaukie, Oregon, 97222, until 2:00 P.M. Pacific Daylight Time, June 26, 1978, at which time the bids will be opened and publicly read aloud.
