Mrs. Bertha Hudson, Education Specialist with the Community Relations Service of the U.S. Department of Justice recently visited Portland to discuss school integration with the Community Coalition and school administrators.

Thirteen youth from the NAACP Youth Council attended a Regional Conference at Santa Rosa, California.
