Santa goes ho, ho, ho I'm off to go.

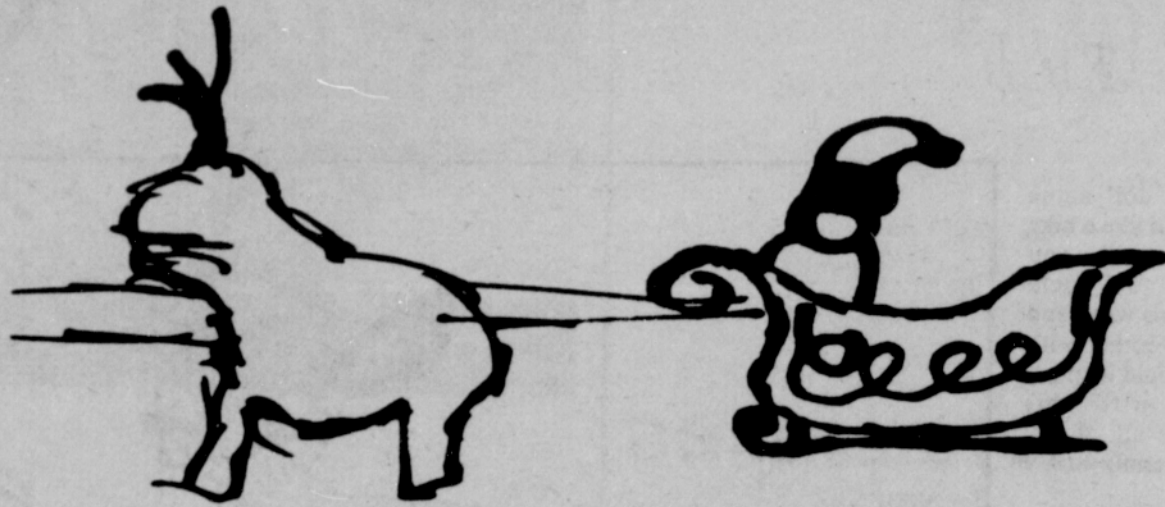

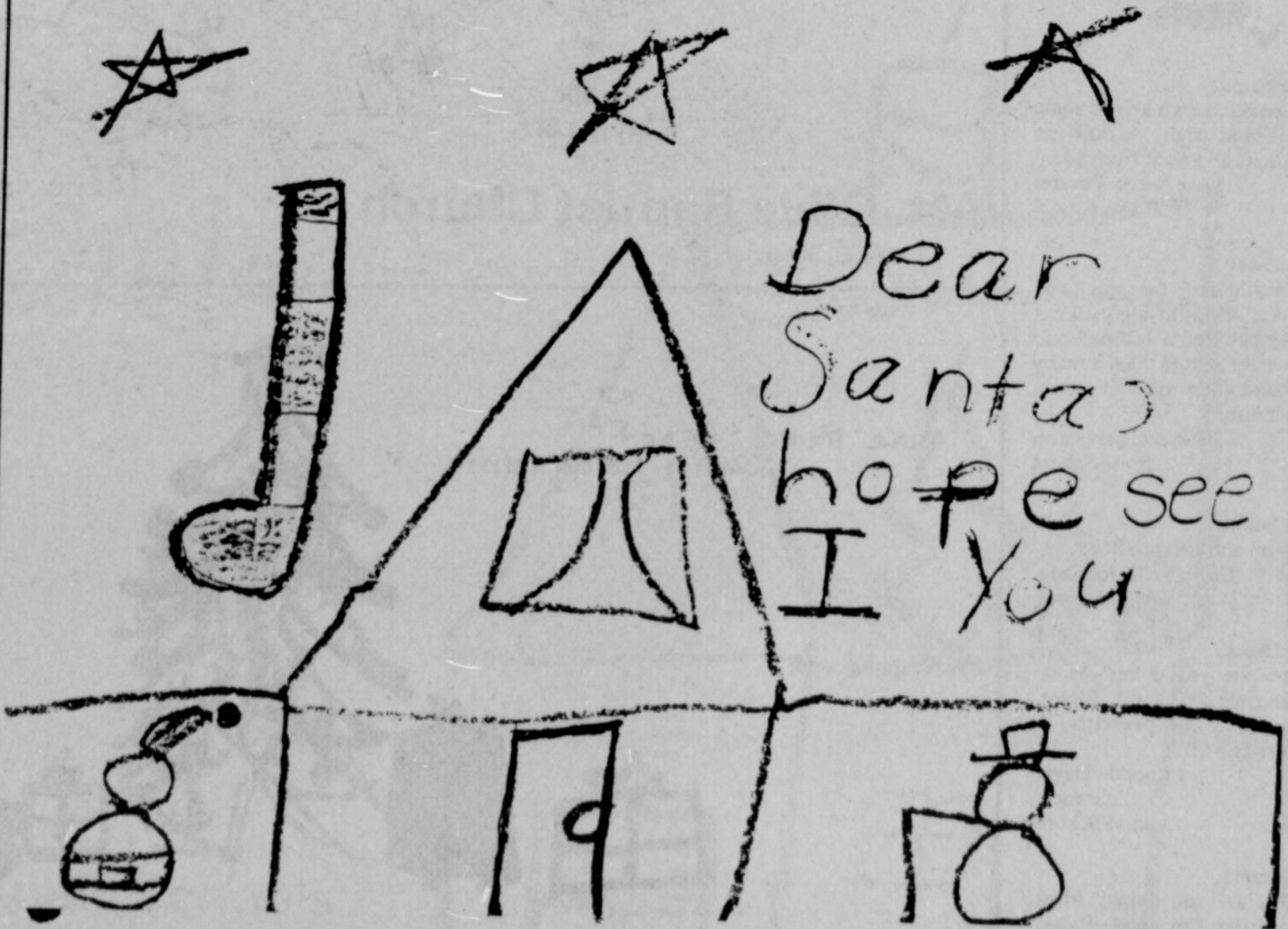
