Bright idea.

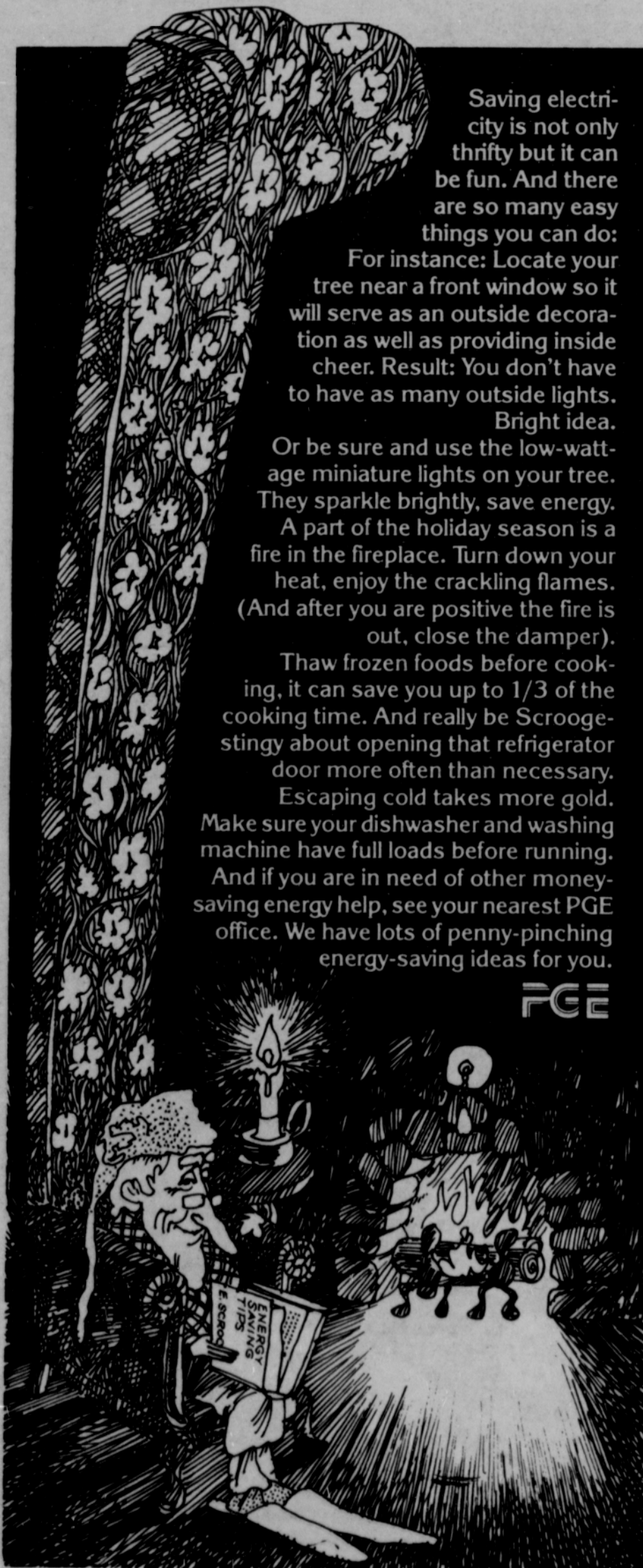
Or be sure and use the low-wattage miniature lights on your tree. They sparkle brightly, save energy.
