Interestingly enough, only last week, when it became apparent that Mugabe was going to win, Peter Walls, commander of the Rhodesian Army, had traveled to Mozambique to reassure the Somora Marcel government that in the event of a Mugabe victory, the to come out of Zimbabwe in almost a century. His 57 seats give enough leeway to be able to push his own programs. He does not have to form a coalition which would have tended to dilute his political orientation. Though he is expected to move rather slowly and cautiously at first, as soon as he is firmly in the saddle, in control of a Zimbabwe national army, he can be expected to provide the kind of leadership the country has yearned for for so long. 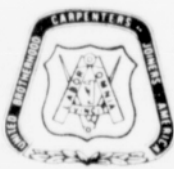

## Invitation to Bid

Sealed proposals for the construction of Old Town Waterline and Sanitary Sewer Improvements (Federal Block Grant Project) within the City of Sherwood, Oregon, will be received at the office of Tad Milburn, City Administrator, City of Sherwood, 90 N.W. Street, Sherwood, Oregon 97140 until 10:00 a.m. Pacific Standard Time, on the 24 day of March, 1980, and then will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The work contemplated consists of schedules of the proposal as follows:

SCHEDULE I - Waterline - Construction consists of approximately 606 linear feet of ten- (10) inch, 1,231 linear feet of eight- (8) inch, and 520 linear feet of six- (6) inch waterline including fire hydrants, gate valves, connections to existing waterlines, and pavement reconstruction.

SCHEDULE II - Sanitary Sewers - Construction consists of approximately 2,095 linear feet of eight- (8) inch sanitary sewer including manholes, service lateral connections, connection to existing sewer lines, plugging the sewers to be abandoned, and pavement reconstruction.

Plans and specifications may be examined at the office of the City Administrator, City of Sherwood, 90 N.W. Park Street, Sherwood, Oregon, 97140. A copy of said documents may be obtained at the office of the City Administrator, City of Sherwood, 90 N.W. Park Street, Sherwood, Oregon 97140 upon deposit of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each document. The full amount of the deposit will be refunded if said documents are returned in good condition within ten (10) days after the award of the contract.

Each proposal must be submitted on the prescribed form and accompanied by a certified check or bid bond payable to the City of Sherwood, in an amount not less than ten percent (10%) of the amount bid.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish a Performance and Payment Bond for faithful performance of the contract in the full amount of the contract price.

Attention is called to the fact that not less than the minimum salaries and wages as set forth in the contract documents must be paid on this project in accordance with ORS 279.350, and that the contractor must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, color, religion, sex, or national origin.

The contract will be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder; the City of Sherwood reserves the right to reject any or all proposals. The City of Sherwood also reserves the right to postpone award of the contract for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days from date of bid opening for the purpose of reviewing the bids, and to accept that proposal which is to the best interests of the City of Sherwood.

Completed prequalification forms must be received by the City ten (10) calendar days before bid opening. Failure to submit prequalification forms ten (10) days in advance will result in automatic disqualification of the bidder. City to notify all noneligible bidders seven (7) days before bid opening.

Prequalifications forms shall be in accordance with ORS 279.039. Forms may be obtained from State of Oregon Public Contract Review Board, Salem, Oregon 97310, or from the City of Sherwood Administration Offices.
