### POLICY STATEMENT

### OREGON DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

It is the policy of the Oregon Department of Transportation that Minority Business Enterprises as defined in Title 49 Code of Federal Regulations Part 23, and as it may be amended, shall have the maximum opportunity to participate in the performance of contracts.

The Department and any recipient of a contract will ensure that discrimination on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, age, religion, mental or physical handicap, political affiliation, or marital status is prohibited.

The responsibilities and objectives of this commitment are described in the Department's MINORITY BUSINESS ENTERPRISE PROGRAM which is available for inspection through the Affirmative Action Section and the EEO and Labor Compliance Unit.
