OBITUARY

The Rev. Ivory James Nicholas, Sr., died May 6, 1981, in Portland, Oregon. He was born in Barton, La., on September 1, 1918, the thirteenth child of Felix and Amy, Louise Nicholas.

The Nicholas family moved to Morgan City, La., when he was seven years old and he spent his adolescence years there. At the age of thirteen he moved to New Orleans, La., where he was educated as a tailor. He later met and married his wife of forty years, the former Maud Esther Delahoussaye. They resided in Yakima, Washington, where five of their six children were born. The Ivory Nicholas family moved to Portland, Oregon in 1956.

Reverend Ivory supported his family in his occupation as a Master Tailor. He began his own dry cleaning business in Yakima, Washington and continued in Nicks Dry Cleaning business in Portland.

Having been a faithful church member, in service as a Deacon

from an early age, he moved his membership to Vancouver, Avenue First Baptist Church, Portland, from Mount Hope Baptist Church in Yakima, Washington. Rev. Nicholas was called into the Gospel Ministry on the nineteenth day of May, 1963.

The Rev. Nicholas is survived by his wife, Maud E. Nicholas; his children, Mrs. Shirley M. Harlow, San Jose, CA.; Mrs. Lula M. Walker; Mrs. Joseph L. Riggins of Portland; Mr. Ansel J. Nicholas of Estacada, OR.; Ivory J. Nicholas, Jr.; David R. Nicholas; Esther M. Nicholas, all of Portland and two foster children, Arthur A. Hayes and Marsha Y. Hayes of Portland; Sixteen grandchildren and one great grandchild. Two foster children and a host of nephews, nieces, cousins and friends. Brother: Mr. Royal Nicholas, Pueblo, Col; sisters: Mrs. Ida Royal and Mrs. Frances Jackson of Morgan City, LA.

district's Desegregation Monitoring Committee, recommended that the middle school be placed at Eliot and that the Boise fundamental program be strengthened. During the Tuesday night hearing, the school board was repeatedly asked to make a more extensive study of population projections and to devise a long-term plan. West side parents threatened withholding of school taxes, and Jackson parents announced they are considering a law suit or succession from the district.

Freddie Pettet, executive director of the Urban League, asked that

Adams and Jefferson High Schools be kept open and said that unless there are significant reasons why Tubman should be put at Boise, it should go to Eliot. She expressed concern for the quality of education provided Black, minority and poor students.

Lucious Hicks, NAACP president, asked that Jefferson and Adams be maintained. "We are receiving so little in the name of education, in the name of desegregation. Shall we sacrifice so much in the name of cost savings?"

The final decision between the Cawthorne and Bill Scott's move to close Adams, Washington/Monroe and Jackson will be made May 4th.
