NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that two public hearings will be held by the Tri-County Metropolitan Transportation District of Oregon (Tri-Met) in the auditorium of the Bonneville Power Administration, 1002 NE Holladay Street at 12:00 noon on Tuesday, September 8, 1981, and 7:30 p.m. on Thursday, September 10, 1981, to receive public comment on proposed bus service changes which will affect passengers in northwest, north, northeast and southeast Portland, and along River Road in north Clackamas County.

Included in these changes is the establishment of a grid-type system within north, northwest and eastside Portland with radical routes and 10 crosstown routes. This network will involve the restructuring or elimination of existing inefficient routes as well as the addition of new routes. Improved service frequency will be provided on key urban routes, seven days a week, to handle passenger volumes and transfers inherent in a grid-type system.

Written or oral comments may be submitted in advance of the hearings to the Board of Directors, Tri-Met, 4012 SE 17th Avenue, Portland, OR 97202, or at the hearing.
