



Education District draws areas

Voters in the Multnomah County Education Service District will vote for MCESD board members by zone in the next election due to legislative action.

In a meeting last week, the board established the boundaries of the zones and assigned board members to the zones.

In previous years, the seven board members of the regional education agency were elected at-large from the district, which encompasses Multnomah County, a small portion of Washington County and an area of Clackamas County in the Damascus-Boring area.

The ESD is now divided into five zones with two board members continuing at-large. Multnomah was the only ESD in the state that was not zoned before the legislative change.

Criteria for establishing the zones included making them equal in population and to conform with school district boundaries and precinct lines wherever possible. Since zoned board members must live in the zone they represent, current board members' positions were tied to the zone they live in. In two zones, there were two board members in the same

zone. In each instance, one position was assigned to the zone and one assigned to the at-large position.

Regional Job Corps officials and various community leaders will attend the charter ceremony as well as the director from the NJCAA Secretariat, headquartered in Washington, D.C. Ron Abernathy, the former NJCAA secretariat director will be the keynote speaker and special congratulations will be offered by Paulette Hilton-Robinson, the 1981 Job Corps Hall of Fame winner.
