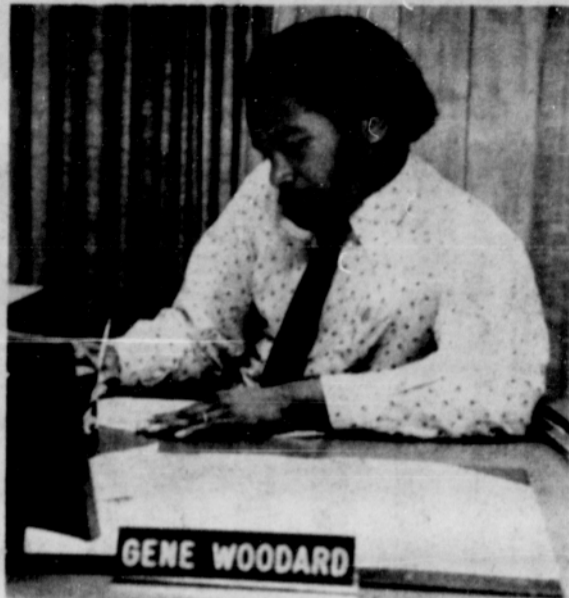




JOYCE GARNETT
