Obituary

George Walter Jordan, a teacher in the Portland School District for 17 years, died in a Portland hospital Thursday, February 18. He was 76.

Funeral services were Tuesday in Caldwell's Colonial Mortuary with interment in Sunset Hills Memorial Park.

Born in Hattisburg, Miss., Mr. Jordan earned his bachelor's degree from Rust College in Holly Springs, Miss., and his master's degree from the University of Portland.

When he first came to Portland, Mr. Jordan worked as a painter in the Oregon Shipyards, and played saxophone with the Walter Bridges Band. His teaching career began in 1954 at the George Elementary school. He retired in 1971, but worked as an evening instructor in the Urban League Outreach program.

Surviving Mr. Jordan are his wife, Martha B; sons, Martin L. Turner and Michael G. Jordan, Bonita Turner, his daughter-in-law, and three granddaughters: Paula Renee Jordan, Kristene Lei Turner and Mechelle Lynne Turner.

Several other relatives, including a brother-in-law and sister-in-law, Mr. and Mrs. Otha B. Ashford from Mississippi who came to be with the family during Mr. Jordan's long illness were in the city to attend the final services.

The Rev. Leon A. Jones of Seattle, a first cousin of the deceased, read the eulogy. The Rev. Jones, who is District Superintendent of Baptist Churches of the Northwest, was assisted in the service by the Rev. Mathew A. Watley of Bethel A.M.E. Church of this city.


Johnnie River of St. Louis was a soloist. Farris Cheeks of Detroit read Tennyson's "Crossing the Bar," and Hurlis Hadley, a former music student of Mr. Jordan, played a saxophone accompaniment to the organist, Calvin Allman.

Other out-of-town persons in attendance at the rites were Mrs. Rubye Jones of Seattle, Kathryn Jones of Seattle, and Kathryn Kinsey of Baltimore.

Honorary pall bearers were: John Williams, Sr., Charles Rawlins, Vernon Chatman, Walter Bridges, Walter Sayles, Oscar Haynes, Edward Johns and Ulysses Leverett.

Active pall bearers were: Michael Jordan, Martin Turner, Leotis McDaniel, Arnie Leppart, Leonard Arnold, Robert Ray, all of Portland, and Nathan Redditt of Eugene.

The family suggests that remembrances be contributions to the American Cancer Society.
