Notice Of Public Hearing

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held by the Tri-County Metropolitan Transportation District of Oregon (Tri-Met) at the Water Services Building Auditorium, 1800 S.W. Sixth Avenue, Portland, Oregon, at 10:00 a.m., Monday, June 28, 1982 for the purpose of considering projects for which financial assistance is being sought from the Urban Mass Transportation under Section 3 of the Urban Transportation Act of 1964, as amended.

The total project cost is \$18,750,000 of which \$15,000,000 is federal share and \$3,750,000 is local share. Projects included in the grant application include:

Land acquisition and construction of three transit centers in 1) Tigard, between Commercial Street and the Southern Pacific Railroad approximately 200 feet south of Main Street;

2) in Milwaukie, on McLoughlin Blvd., between S.E. Jackson Street and S.E. Monroe Street; and 3) in Oregon City on Railroad Avenue between 7th Street and 8th Street;

purchase of 36 medium duty vehicles, life equipped for service to elderly and handicapped;

land acquisition and construction of a park and ride lot in Beaverton just east of the intersection of the reconstructed Tualatin Valley (TV) Hwy. and S.W. 160th Avenue;

preliminary engineering for minor inner-city transit transfer improvements including sidewalk widenings, pedestrian crossings and shelter amenities;

first phase of funding for bus replacement order design and construction of an access road to the Westside Maintenance facility at 185th and Merlo Road;

Transportation System Management Improvements in Washington County including shelter installation, bus stop and access improvements at 24 locations along the TV highway and 37 locations along 185th Avenue;

land acquisition and preliminary engineering for the Sunset Transit Center, a major timed-transfer center located north of Hwy. 217 and Sunset Hwy. interchange;

design and construction of minor eastside transportation system improvements including shelter installation, concrete pads, corner cutbacks; construction improvements at the Barbur Transit Station.

These projects are included in the METRO Transportation Improvement Program and will be in the annual element for FY'82. Persons, families or businesses will be displaced by the proposed transit centers in Tigard, Oregon City and Milwaukie. Relocation information will be provided at the hearing.

At the hearing, Tri-Met will afford an opportunity for interested persons or agencies to be heard with respect to the social, economic and environmental aspects of the project. Interested persons may submit oral or written evidence and recommendations with respect to the project.

Bids submitted prior to the opening will be received by Charleston Sanitary District, 4570 Eal Avenue, P.O. Box 5522, Charleston, Oregon. Bid opening will be conducted at the Charleston Sanitary District Office, and publicly opened and read aloud.

The project, entitled Charleston Sanitary District/Coos County - Service Laterals, consists of approximately 52 houses to be connected to service laterals.

One copy may be obtained by prequalified prospective bidders upon receipt of cash or check in the amount of \$50.00 made payable to the Engineer. Deposits made upon procurement of drawings, specifications, and forms of Contract Documents will be refunded upon the return thereof in good condition by actual bidders within the ten days after the opening of bids. Non-bidders deposits will be refunded if documents are returned, in good condition, no later than 15 days from date of bid opening. Deposits retained will cover cost of printing. Individual sheets and specifications pages may be purchased for the cost of reproduction, at \$0.25 per sheet.

Bidders must pre-qualify with Owner, on Standard APWA Prequalification forms, ten (10) days prior to bid opening. Prequalification forms may be obtained from, and should be submitted to the Engineer. If a prequalification form is on file with the Engineer and is not over one year old, refiling is not necessary unless there has been a substantial change in Contractor's status.

The Offeror's of Bidder's attention is called to the "Equal Opportunity Clause," the "Standard Federal Equal Employment Opportunity Construction Contract Specifications," and "Section 3" Requirements set forth herein.

The Contractor's compliance with the Executive Order and the regulation of CFE Part 60-4 shall be based on its implementation of the Equal Opportunity Clause, specific affirmative action obligation required by the specifications set forth in 41 CFR 50-4.3 (a), and its effort to meet the goals established for the geographical area where the contract resulting from this solicitation is to be performed. The hours of minority and female employment and training must be substantially uniform throughout the length of the contract and in each trade and the Contractor shall make a good faith effort to employ minorities and women evenly on each of its projects. The transfer of minority or female employees or trainees from Contractor to Contractor or from project to project for the sole purpose of meeting the Contractor goals shall be a violation of the contract, the Executive Order and the regulations in 41 CFR Part 60-4. Compliance with the goals will be measured against the total work hours performed.

The Contractor shall provide a written notification to the Director of the Office of Federal Contract Compliance Programs within 10 working days of award of any construction subcontract in excess of \$10,000 at any tier of construction work under the contract resulting from this solicitation. The notification shall list the name, address and telephone number of the subcontractor, employer identification number, estimated dollar amount of the subcontract; estimated starting and completion dates of the subcontract, and the geographical area in which the contract is to be performed.

As used in this notice, and in the contract resulting from this solicitation, the covered area is the Coos Bay area.

Prospective Contractors for work in connection with Section 3 covered projects will be required to provide, prior to signing of the contract, a preliminary statement of work force needs (skilled, semi-skilled, unskilled labor and trainees by category) where known, where not known, such information shall be supplied prior to the signing of any contract between contractors and their subcontractors.

This project is being financed by Community Development Block Grant Funds from the Department of Housing and Urban Development. Coos County is the recipient of the funds in behalf of the Charleston Sanitary District and Coos County is responsible for administration of the grant funds.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive all informalities. No bidder may withdraw or modify his bid after the hour set for the opening and thereafter until the lapse of sixty (60) days from the bid.

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held by the Tri-County Metropolitan Transportation District of Oregon (Tri-Met) at the Water Services Building Auditorium, 1800 S.W. Sixth Avenue, Portland, Oregon at 10:00 a.m., Monday, June 28th, 1982 for the purpose of considering a project for which financial assistance is being sought from the Urban Mass Transportation Administration through an amendment to an existing capital grant under Section 3 of the Urban Mass Transportation Act of 1964, as amended.

This project includes purchase of five medium duty mini-buses with lifts and five radios specially designed for elderly and handicapped service. The total project cost is \$182,051 (\$145,641-federal funds and \$36,410-local funds). A description of the entire scope of Tri-Met's service to the elderly and handicapped will be provided at the hearing.

This project is included in the MSD Transportation Improvement Program and will be in the annual element for FY'82. No persons, families, or businesses will be displaced by this project. There will be no significant environmental impact by this project upon the service area.
