Caption: Repeal of charter amendments and referral to Charter Review Committee.


Question: Shall Charter amendments adopted in 1982 Primary be repealed and those issues be studied by Charter Review Committee?

Purpose: This measure repeals amendments to Charter adopted in May 1982. Those amendments: made following offices elective rather than appointive; sheriff, county clerk, district court clerk, and assessor; required salaries of county elective officials be set by popular vote at primary or general election; limited tenures of elected officials to eight years, retroactive to 1976; prohibited paid county lobbyist; vested jail administration in sheriff; provided candidacy for different office automatically resulted in resignation from current office.
