Policy Statement

PORT OF PORTLAND - FISCAL YEAR 1983
MINORITY BUSINESS ENTERPRISE PROGRAM

It is the policy of the Port of Portland Commission to establish goals whereby minority- and women-owned businesses have the opportunity to participate in Portwide and airport construction contracts, and are given the opportunity to bid on airport concession leases and service contracts; and

That approval is given to the Fiscal Year 1983 Minority Business Enterprise Program to stimulate minority business enterprise participation in the Port's competitive bidding process and in airport concession leases and service contracts; and

That such a program consist of:

- (1) A goal of 9 percent participation by minority business enterprises and 3 percent participation by women-owned enterprises in Portwide and federally funded construction projects in fiscal year 1983 and solicitation of minority/women business enterprises to compete in airport concession leases and service contracts; and
- (2) Distribution of contents of the program throughout the Port offices and to minority and nonminority communities' business organizations and publications.

The Port will evaluate and adjust the substance of the program annually.
