Sealed Proposals for the Construction of the West Main Collection System and Northside Rehabilitation, addressed to the City Recorder, City of Sheridan, 139 N.W. Yamhill St., Sheridan, Oregon 97378, until 4:30 p.m., local time, on the 17th day of May 1983, and then will be publicly opened and read.

The Work contemplated is as follows:

SCHEDULE A: Construction of the Sewage Collection system serving the West Main Area including 12,025 linear feet of 8 and 10-inch sewer pipe, 1,920 linear feet of 6-inch pressure pipe, 2,750 linear feet of 4 and 6-inch service pipe, manholes, surface restoration, 3 railroad undercrossings, one (1) Wet Well mounted type pump station, and other appurtenances.

SCHEDULE B: Construction of a replacement Sewage Collection system on the Northside of the City of Sheridan, including 2,476 linear feet of 12 and 15-inch sewer pipe, 760 linear feet of 4 and 6-inch service pipe, manholes, surface restoration, 12 connections of the existing mainline system to the replacement line, 51 connections of existing 4 and 6-inch service connections to the replacement line, and other appurtenances.

SCHEDULE D: Construction of a relocated waterline serving the West Main Area, including 6,095 linear feet of 6 and 8-inch water pipe, ¾ to 1 ½-inch service connection pipe, 3 connections of the existing mainline system to the relocated line, 31 connections of existing water service connections to the replacement line, one (1) railroad undercrossing, valves, fittings, hydrant installation, surface restoration, and other appurtenances.

Before a Contract will be awarded for the work contemplated herein, the Owner will conduct such investigation as is necessary to determine the performance record and ability of the apparent low bidder to perform the size and type of work specified under this Contract. Upon request, the Bidder shall submit such information as deemed necessary by the Owner to evaluate the Bidder's qualifications.

Each proposal must be submitted on the prescribed form and accompanied by a certified check or bid bond executed on the prescribed form, payable to the City of Sheridan, Yamhill County, Oregon, in an amount not less than 10 percent of the amount bid.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish a bond for faithful performance and payment of the contract as prescribed in the Contract Documents.

Bidders on this project will be required to comply with the provisions of the President's Executive Order No. 11246 and requirements issued thereunder. The requirements for Bidders and Contractors under this Order are specified in the Contract Documents.

Sealed Proposals for the construction of Tri-City Service District, Sewage Treatment Plant, Preload, Contract C1, addressed to Board of County Commissioners, Clackamas County, OR, will be received at the office of the Department of Environmental Services, 902 Abernethy Road, Oregon City, OR 97045, until 2:00 p.m., local time, on the 17th day of May 1983, and then will be publicly opened and read.

Ten to fifteen percent of construction supplies and materials shall be procured from minority-owned suppliers.

Prior to award of a contract, EPA will review the proposals with respect to the Bidder's degree of compliance with the above goals; a low bidder who has not achieved these goals must demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Director, Office of Civil Rights and Urban Affairs, EPA Region X, that the goals are not attainable on the Contract work.

Any contract awarded under this Invitation to Bid is expected to be funded in part by a grant from the United States Environmental Protection Agency. Neither the United States nor any of its departments, agencies, or employees is or will be a party to this Invitation to Bid or any resulting Contract.
