original Title I legislation. Over 800,000 migrant children nationwide are served by the program in 49 states plus Puerto Rico and Washington, D.C. (Hawaii is the only state without a program.) The conference is held annually to provide program personnel the opportunity to meet and plan for interstate cooperation. It provides them an opportunity to share problems and solutions. Teachers, instructional aides, administrators, home-school liaison personnel and parents participate. Currently, attendance for this conference is estimated at 1,000-1,200.
