WEST RAINIER WATER AND SEWER PROJECT

Sealed Bids for the construction of SANITARY SEWERS, PUMPING STATION AND WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS in the City of Rainier, Oregon addressed to the Mayor and City Council, 106 B West, P.O. Box A, Rainier, Oregon 97048 will be received until 2:30 p.m. local time on the 2nd day of June, 1983, in the City Recorder's Office in City Hall at the above address at which time bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The project consists of constructing approximately 8,723 lineal feet of 8, 10, 12 & 15 inch diameter gravity-flow sewers; bored railroad undercrossings; a factory-built, triplex sewage pumping station and 3,000 lineal feet of force main; and 5,863 lineal feet of 12 inch diameter water distribution main.

The Contract Documents may be examined at the Rainier City Hall at the Northwest Plan Center; and at the office of the Engineers, Whiteley, Jacobsen & Associates in Portland, and Seattle.

A Pre-Bid Conference at which test holes will be excavated to allow bidders to observe subsurface conditions will be held May 19th at 10:30 a.m., beginning at the Rainier City Shops.

Each Bid must contain a statement by the Bidder that the provisions of ORS 279.350 shall be complied with.

Prospective Bidders are advised that the work is partially funded by a grant from the U.S. Department of Commerce, Economic Development Administration and that the work will be subject to the prevailing wage rates established by the U.S. Department of Labor and to Equal Employment Opportunity requirements.

Each proposal must be submitted on the prescribed form and accompanied by a certified check or bid bond payable to the City of Rainier, Oregon in an amount of not less than 10 percent of the total amount of the Bid.
