Sealed bids will be received by the Oregon State Board of Higher Education in Administrative Services Building, 8100, Oregon State University, Corvallis, Oregon until 2:00 p.m., PDT, July 7, 1983 for the Milne Computer Center Air Conditioning Modification project located on the campus of Oregon State University, Corvallis, Oregon. Bids will be opened and publicly read aloud in the Administrative Services Building "A", Room A110 by the Undersigned or his designated representative.

The project consists of furnishing all labor, material, equipment, superintending and doing all work to do certain demolition, sheetmetal ductwork, relocating certain equipment, installing a heat recovery refrigeration chiller, packaged air handler unit, miscellaneous items and all associated controls, piping, mechanical and electrical work all in strict accordance with the drawings and specifications.

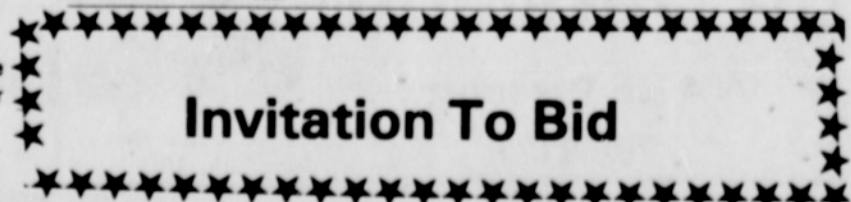
