Muslim Mission promotes collective buying

Grassroots News, N.W. — The American Muslim Mission has currently been reaping the fruits of their collective resources with the purchase and distribution of over 500 chickens. Brother John Hart explains, "We had a farmer grow, for our collective buying effort, 500 chickens which recently reached maturity. We slaughtered the fowl in a traditional Islamic Way. The bird is calm and his counterpart cannot see him being slaughtered. We know that this makes a difference when you eat it. It has been my personal experience that some meats have an affect on you because of the way it has been slaughtered."

Hart says there are about 55 families participating in this collective buying. "The main feature here is the collective effect. We have shown the community what a collective effort can accomplish. This is just a small example of what the community can do as a whole. Collective buying is just one of the processes that we are going to have to use when we have such high unemployment and food costs. This is a method that we must use if we are

going to survive." Collective buying is not new to the American Muslim Mission. During their process of growth, when they were called the Nation of Islam, collective buying was an intrinsic part of the organization. "Well, this is not a co-op. It is a similar situation, but we are more organized. We are equipped to handle more families. Before we had brothers going door to door selling fish. Now, we want to be able to encompass up to 500 families."

Muhammad Najieb and his family are involved in this collective buying effort. "Collective buying is the only way we as consumers can benefit. As high as food prices are, collective buying is the only intelligent way that we as a community can pool our resources together to maximize our purchasing power."
