The CITY OF ST. HELENS invites bids for the following:

TENNIS COURT SURFACE

A finish surface to be applied to an existing asphalt double tennis court (110' x 122') in Campbell Park, City of St. Helens, Oregon.

The project shall consist of the application of a techtone or equivalent resurfacing system as follows:

- (a) Two coats of resurfacer (Surfix TT 650 or equivalent) to free the asphalt of any voids or birdbaths.
- (b) Two coats of colored acrylic base filler (TT 630 Filler Kote or equivalent). Sand or acrylic can be added to regulate speed of play.
- (c) Apply top coat of colored acrylic (TT 620 Top Kote or equivalent). Color to be chosen by the City of St. Helens' Park Department.
- (d) Lining and striping to single and double play regulation specifications with Techtone or equivalent striping paint.

Bids must be sealed and submitted in writing to contracting officer by the time of the public opening which is 4:00 p.m., September 20, 1983. Pre-qualification requests are not desired or necessary but must be received by 4:00 p.m., September 16, 1983, if submitted. All envelopes must be sealed and plainly marked on the outside showing the name of bidder, date and time of the bid opening, the project name, and the words "sealed bid." A 10% bid bond and a performance bond will be required. A City business license is also required for doing business in the City.

The project will be partly funded through Federal Land and Water Conservation Funds, the receipt of which will necessitate compliance with certain federal regulations.

No bids will be received or considered unless the bid contains a statement that the provisions regarding prevailing rates of wage required by ORS 279.350 and the Davis-Bacon Act, as may be applicable, shall be complied with.

All bidders must be willing to comply with the applicable provisions of the Equal Employment Opportunity Act of 1972, the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended, and the Copeland "Anti-Kickback" Act (18 U.S.C. 874).

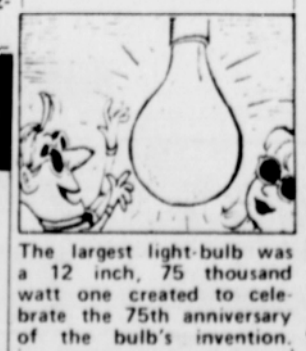
