The science and technology projects are designed to be demonstrative projects and are funded by a grant from the Fred Meyer Charitable Trust.

Creative thinking and problem solving will be the focus of the joint accelerated learning program which will involve classroom simulations for all students and off campus activities for the "talented and gifted."

BUSINESS NOTES

Supplemental jobless payments would be extended 18 months beyond the program's current expiration date next Friday, under legislation approved by the Senate Finance Committee. The bill is less generous than an extension passed earlier this week by the House Ways and Means panel.

Several KBOO programs will soon be underwritten by the Portland Observer which is also providing FREE six-month subscriptions for all \$25 annual pledges sent in with a coupon printed in the Observer, Portland's award-winning (and largest) Black-owned newspaper.

Despite what Governor Atiyeh, the outspoken business lobby and the major Oregon newspaper say about Oregon's business climate, the Carnation Company of Los Angeles just made a \$10.5 million investment here. A new packaging and feed mill operation was dedicated by the company in the South Rivergate area last Saturday. Columbia Grain is currently expanding their own plant right next door with a \$17 million investment. According to Carnation officials, the new plant is the most advanced feed mill in the country.

A new bridge connecting North Lombard with North Marine Drive over the Columbia Slough in the Rivergate Industrial District will be built soon. A \$767,631 contract for the bridge construction was recently awarded by the Port of Portland to F.E. Ward, Inc. The bridge will eliminate a six-mile drive now necessary to bypass the Columbia Slough. Congestion on streets in St. Johns and on Columbia Blvd. will be lessened with the new bridge. Total cost is \$1,359,000.
