Sealed bids will be received by the Metropolitan Service District, 527 S.W. Hall Street, Portland, Oregon 97201 on or before 12:00 p.m., November 18, 1983 for a Truck Wash Facility at the Clackamas Transfer and Recycle Center (CTRC) in Oregon City.

Major work items include concrete slabs and foundations, asphalt paving, and utilities.

Each bid will be in accordance with plans and specification which are incorporated by reference herein, copies of which are available at the Metro offices.

Each bid shall be sealed and addressed to Metro and plainly marked as to the work on which the bid is being placed. Each bid shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or satisfactory bid bond made out to the order of the Metropolitan Service District, Portland, Oregon in an amount not less than ten percent (10%) of the bid. Each bid shall have attached thereto the list of subcontractors the bidder proposes to use, and any bid not having this attached list will be disqualified from bidding.

Metro has a policy goal of encouraging Minority Business Enterprise participation. The policy is applicable on all contracts by Metro.

All bidders must comply with provisions of Oregon Revised Statutes, Chapter 279, part of which relates to prequalification of bidders and payment of prevailing wage rates.

Metro reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids and waive any formalities. Actual commencement of the contract is conditioned on Metro's successful receipt of necessary permits.
