Scheduled for broadcast November 2 and 9 at 8:00 p.m. on Oregon Public Broadcasting stations, *The Chemical People* is designed to spur communities to establish permanent task forces to attack substance abuse in their area.

The programs, which will be aired nationwide, were produced by WQED-TV/Pittsburgh with funding from the Richard King Mellon Foundation and the Metropolitan Life Foundations.
