Sealed bids for the Corbett Acres Water Project will be received by the Grand Ronde Community Water Association until 2:00 p.m. local time on November 29, 1983. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at the above time and date at the Association's office located at 26690 Salmon River Highway (Highway 18), Willamina, Oregon, 97396.

Proposals shall be clearly marked "Bid for Corbett Acres Water Project" along with the time and date of bid opening and shall be delivered before the above hour and date to the Association office at 26690 Salmon River Highway, Willamina, Oregon, 97396.

The work consists of the following construction:

Schedule A: Approximately 3400 l.f. of 6" waterline, 34,000 l.f. of 4" waterline, 15,000 l.f. of 3" waterline, 4,200 l.f. of 2" waterline, pressure reducing valves, gate valves, creek crossings, 84 services, and miscellaneous work. In addition, a factory built booster pump station and associated sitework, protective structure, piping, electrical and miscellaneous appurtenant work.

Schedule B: 100,000 gallon steel water reservoir, complete with associated piping, sitework and miscellaneous appurtenant work.

This project is being funded in part by the Farmer's Home Administration (FmHA), and FmHA approval of the low bid(s) and subsequent contract(s) will be necessary.

Notice Of Public Hearing

Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held by the Tri-County Metropolitan Transportation District of Oregon (Tri-Met) at the Portland Building, 1120 SW 5th Avenue, Second Floor, Meeting Room "C" at 10:00 a.m., Monday, November 28, 1983, for the purpose of considering grant amendment applications to the Urban Mass Transportation Administration for land acquisition, engineering, construction and building modifications for the Milwaukie Transit Center. A new site is under consideration for the proposed new Milwaukie Transit Center on the property bounded by the Southern Pacific Railroad, Adams Street, Main Street and Kellogg Lake. If approved the grant amendments would allow reprogramming of funds previously approved for the Milwaukie Transit Center at another site.

The grant amendments include \$385,000 (federal share—\$308,000, local share—\$77,000) in grant OR-05-0006 and \$830,230 (federal share—\$664,184, local share—\$166,046) in grant OR-03-0027.

No persons, families or businesses will be displaced by the project.

An environmental assessment with a recommended finding of no significant impact is available for public inspection at the Tri-Met Administration offices.

In keeping with Tri-Met's policy regarding design of facilities, transit centers will promote accessibility through widened sidewalks, wheelchair ramps, and specially designated parking spaces for the elderly and handicapped.

The project is currently under review by the A-95 clearinghouse and will be included in the FY'84 annual element of the Transportation Improvement Program.

A statement of Tri-Met's proposed charter bus service is available for inspection at the Tri-Met Administration offices.

Tri-Met will not be engaging in school bus operation. There will be no direct impact on private transportation enterprise by these projects.

At the hearing Tri-Met will afford an opportunity for interested persons to be heard with respect to the social, economic and environmental aspects of the projects. Interested persons may submit, orally or in writing, evidence and recommendations with respect to the project.
