Bids for the 1984 Comprehensive Improvement Assistance Program Weatherization MOD Project No. ON-014-901, Job No. 1, consisting of ceiling, floor, wall and duct insulation, will be received by Marion County Housing Authority, 4660 Portland Rd. ### SITE IMPROVEMENTS

The Housing Authority of Portland is requesting bids for site improvements on two lots located at the Northeast corner of S.E. 94th & Stark St., Portland, OR.

Lump sum bids will be accepted in sealed envelope with the following title, "Site Improvement Bid" clearly printed on face of envelope, and will be received at 1605 N.E. 45th Ave., Portland, Oregon 97213, until 3:00 p.m., P.S.T., Thursday, December 22, 1983, and a short duration thereafter opened and read aloud. Bidders may attend the bid opening.

Briefly, the work consists of the removal of brush and plant growth from lots; the removal of portions of asphalt paving and concrete walkways; the installation of concrete planter curbs, sidewalks, street curbs and approaches; the grading of lots as required and removal of steel sign posts.

A pre-bid inspection of the work area and conditions will be conducted by a HAP representative at the job site at 10:00 a.m., Thursday, December 8, 1983. All questions regarding the work will be answered at that time and bidders are urged to attend.

No bid will be accepted or considered unless the bid contains a statement by the bidder, as part of the bid, that the provisions required by OR 83-5111, dated 6-10-83 (workmen on public works to be paid not less than prevailing rate of wage) shall be complied with. Sealed Proposals for the construction of City of North Plains, Oregon, Community Storm Drainage, Culverting and Street Improvements, addressed to the City Recorder, City of North Plains, P.O.
