Sealed bids will be received by the Oregon State Board of Higher Education in Administrative Services Building, B100, Oregon State University, Corvallis, Oregon until 2:00 PM, PST, December 29, 1983, for the Mark O. Hatfield Marine Science Center Dock Renovations project located at the Marine Science Center, Newport, Oregon. Bids will be opened and publicly read aloud in the Administrative Services Building "A," Room A110 by the Undersigned or his designated representative.

The project consists of furnishing all labor, material, equipment, superintendence and doing all work to make certain repairs to the ship dock, trestle, and catwalk including replacing piles, pile caps, bracing timbers, and miscellaneous items all in strict accordance with the drawings and specifications.

Bids will be received on a lump-sum basis for all of the work. All bids must contain a statement assuring compliance with ORS 279.350 relating to prevailing rates of wage.

No bid will be considered unless fully completed in the manner provided in the "Instructions to Bidders" upon the Bid Form provided and accompanied by Bid Security executed in favor of the State of Oregon and the Oregon State Board of Higher Education in an amount equal to ten (10) percent of the total amount of the bid, to be forfeited as fixed and liquidated damages should the bidder neglect or refuse to enter into a contract and provide suitable Bond for the faithful performance of the work in the event the contract is awarded to the bidder.

The Oregon State Board of Higher Education reserves the right to reject all bids and to waive all informalities.

DBE/WBE GOALS

It is the policy of the Tri-County Metropolitan Transportation District of Oregon (Tri-Met) that Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBEs) and Women Business Enterprises (WBEs), as defined in 49 CFR 23.62 and 23.5, respectively, shall have the maximum opportunity to participate in the performance of contracts and subcontracts financed in whole or in part with federal funds from the U.S. Department of Transportation.

In this regard, Tri-Met has established overall goals for Federal Fiscal Year 1983-1984 of 10% DBE and 1% WBE participation in federally-assisted contracts.

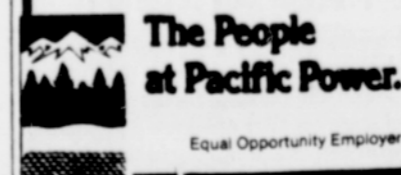
