Gospel group sings good news

"Gospel music is good news. Anybody can sing but to glorify is something else," is how David Love warmed up to the topic of the New Light Gospel group.

New Light Gospel is an interracial group whose age range is from 21 to 45. Their repertoire of songs includes: "Come Over Here," "I Can

Tell The World About This," "Wade in the Water," "Mary Don't You Weep," "Handwriting On The Wall," and "Atom Bomb." The "bomb" should get a lot of attention during this nuclear age.

David Love and Louis Johnson formed New Light Gospel three years ago. Previously they had performed with the Silvertones, a Portland gospel group. In addition, Love's leadership ability dates to another group, the Lord's Physicians, which toured the Pacific Northwest and the west coast's "glorifying" the Lord through music and song.

According to Love, when they perform, the audience see what the Lord has done for them. "How obviously he has made us happy," he said. "We feel so strong about it that we show it through song, dance, drama and everything else."

New Light Gospel is an aggregation of seven: David Love, leader, guitar, accordion and "any other" instrument in the band; Louis Johnson, lead guitar and keyboards; Jonathan Johnson, baritone; Kathleen Johnson, second soprano; Mary Love, first soprano and bass; John Teasley, percussions; and Viola Teasley, second soprano.
