"Step Into Spring," a benefit dinner and fashion show sponsored by the Portland Chapter of Jack and Jill of America, will be presented March 18th in the east Ballroom of the Red Lion at Jantzen Beach, beginning at 3:30 p.m.

Jack and Jill of America, Incorporated is a family oriented organization, founded in 1938 in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. The overall goal of the organization is to stimulate a social, educational, and cultural relationship among Black children. The national group has grown from a group of twenty mothers into a family membership of over 30,000 located throughout the United States. The Portland Chapter was chartered with twenty-four members on August 18, 1958; and to date has a membership of 34 families.

Traditionally, one-half of the funds raised are submitted to the National Jack and Jill Foundation. This non-profit tax exempt organization funds several hundred educational programs throughout the nation. For example, in 1975, the Black Educational Center of Portland was the recipient of these funds.

A fund raising effort, the 1984 recipient is the Albina Ministerial Alliance North Portland Nurse Practitioner Clinic (Preventive Dentistry Program). The Clinic was established in the Portland Area in 1982 by Mrs. Mariah Taylor, R.N.

According to Mrs. Elaine Jamison, president of the Portland Jack and Jill of America, Inc. Chapter, "with the help of the Portland community, we will be able to assist Mrs. Taylor in meeting her goals: to help clients receive necessary preventive dental education and services." The Clinic

needs help providing funding for dental screening, dental information, and dental supplies for its clients. Mrs. Taylor lists her clients as individuals ranging from birth to 21 years old.
