Sealed proposals for furnishing all materials, equipment and labor for the construction of water lines for the Hazelwood Water District will be received at the District office at 1017 N.E. 117th Avenue, Portland, Oregon, 97220, until 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, March 22, 1984. Immediately thereafter such proposals will be publicly opened and read. A contract will be awarded or bids rejected within sixty (60) days after the opening.

The proposed work consists of furnish and installing 240 lineal feet of 12-inch diameter, 665 feet of 8-inch diameter and 6,667 lineal feet of 6-inch diameter ductile iron, Class 52 pipe, including corrosion protection for piping, excavation, backfill, thrust restraint, valves, fittings and appurtenances. Included are two encased 16" and 18" water main crossings of E. Burnside Street. Also included is the installation of approximately 45 house services consisting of furnishing and installing approximately 725 lineal feet of 3/4-inch and 510 lineal feet of 1-inch copper service line, connections, corporation stops, curb stop, handwheel valves, excavation, backfill, surface restoration and appurtenances.

BETWEEN MARION AND UNION STREETS.

PROPOSED WORK

ORGANIZATION OF BID SCHEDULES, ALTERNATE BIDS, BASIS OF AWARD. It is the City's intent to award one contract for the work on this project. Depending on bids, a single contract will be awarded for either Alternate A or Alternate B, whichever is lowest.

ALTERNATE A. Alternate A consists of removal and replacement of 346 lineal feet of 8-inch pipe.

ALTERNATE B. Alternate B consists of installing 346 lineal feet of 8-inch diameter 6mm insituform liner pipe after repairing a pipe grade dip.

Plans, specifications and other bid documents may be inspected and obtained at the office of the City of Salem, Department of Public Works, 555 Liberty Street S.E., Room 325, Salem, Oregon. The bidder shall not file the book of "Standard Construction Specifications" with his bid.

Bids shall be made on the forms furnished by the City, addressed, and mailed or delivered to the City Purchasing Agent, City Hall, Salem, Oregon, in a sealed envelop plainly marked "BID ON THE REHABILITATION OF A SANITARY SEWER IN ALLEY WEST OF LIBERTY STREET N.E. A surety bond, cashier's check or certified check of the bidder, made payable to the City of Salem, in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the bid must accompany each bid as security. Bid security of all save the three lowest bidders will be returned following the bid opening; all bid security will be refunded upon execution of the contract by the successful bidder.
