Invitation to Bidders

CITY OF SPRINGFIELD
PUBLIC WORKS IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Scaled bids will be received by the Finance Department of the City of Springfield, 225 North 5th Street, Springfield, Oregon, until 2:00 p.m., the 22nd day of March, 1984, for the Construction of the following public works project in the City of Springfield:

Storm drainage trunk located in Industrial Boulevard - Centennial Boulevard Right-of-Way between North 32nd Street and Drainage Channel just east of North 28th Street, and Vicinity. (Adam's Plat Storm Drainage System Project No. 83-519-04)

Bid documents are available from the Department of Public Works of the City of Springfield, 225 North 5th Street, Springfield, Oregon 97477 for a non-refundable fee of \$20.00.

The project will be funded in part with monies made available by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development under the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 AND THE "EMERGENCY JOBS BILL" OF 1983. The receipt of these funds necessitates compliance with certain Federal Regulation.

THE CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THIS PROJECT WILL ENCOURAGE THE CONTRACTOR TO MAXIMIZE THE CREATION OF EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES FOR INDIVIDUALS WHO WERE UNEMPLOYED AT LEAST FIFTEEN OF THE TWENTY-SIX WEEKS PRIOR TO MARCH 24, 1983. THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, BASED UPON THE CONTRACTOR'S INDICATED PROJECT WORK FORCE NEEDS, WILL NOTIFY THE OREGON STATE EMPLOYMENT DIVISION OF JOB OPPORTUNITIES THAT MAY BE EXPECTED TO BECOME AVAILABLE. THE OREGON STATE EMPLOYMENT DIVISION WILL TAKE APPROPRIATE ACTION TO IDENTIFY INDIVIDUALS WHO MAY BE EXPECTED TO HAVE SKILLS NEEDED BY THE CONTRACTOR AND WHO MEET THE ABOVE EMPLOYMENT CRITERION.

In accordance with ORS 279.039, the City of Springfield will require that no bid at a total cost of \$10,000 or over shall be received from any contractor who has not filed with the Department of Public Works a Prequalification Statement on forms prescribed by that department at least 30 days prior to the date of bid opening and been found to be prequalified except that said forms need be filed only one time in any calendar year.

No bid will be received or considered by the public body or any officer of the public body unless the bid contains a statement by the bidder as part of the bid that the provisions regarding prevailing rates of wage required by ORS 279.350 and the Davis Bacon Act (40 USC 276a et seq) as may be applicable, shall be complied with.

All bidders must be willing to comply with the applicable provisions of the Equal Employment Opportunity Act of 1972; The Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended; Section 3 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended; and Executive Order 11246 (as supplemented in 41 CFR, Part 60).

The Offeror's or Bidder's attention is called to the "Equal Opportunity Clause" and the "Standard Federal Equal Employment Specifications" set forth herein.

The goals and time tables for minority and female participation, expressed in percentage terms for the Contractor's aggregate work force in each trade on all construction work in the covered area, are as follows:

These goals are applicable to all the Contractor's construction work (whether or not it is Federal or federally assisted) performed in the covered area. If the contractor performs construction work in a geographical area located outside of the covered area, it shall apply the goals established for such geographical area where the work is actually performed. With regard to this second area, the contractor also is subject to the goals for both its federally involved and non-federally involved construction.

The Contractor's compliance with the Executive Order and the Regulations in CFR Part 60-4 shall be based on its implementation of the Equal Opportunity Clause, specific affirmative action obligations required by the specifications set forth in 41 CFR 60-4.3 (a), and its efforts to meet the goals. The hours of minority and female employment and training must be substantially uniform throughout the length of the contract, and in each trade, and the contractor shall make a good faith effort to employ minorities and women evenly on each of its projects. The transfer of minority or female employees or trainees from Contractor to Contractor or from project to project for the sole purpose of meeting the Contractor's goals shall be a violation of the contract, the Executive Order and the Regulations in 41 CFR Part 60-4. Compliance with the goals will be measured against the total work hours performed.

The Contractor shall provide written notification to the Director of the Office of Federal Contract Compliance Programs within ten (10) working days of award of any construction subcontract in excess of \$10,000 at any tier for construction work under the contract resulting from this solicitation. The notification shall list the name, address and telephone number of the subcontractor; employer identification number of the subcontractor; estimated dollar amount of the subcontract; estimated starting and completion dates of the subcontract; and the geographical area in which the subcontract is to be performed.

As used in this Invitation to Bidders, and in the contract resulting from this solicitation, the "covered area" is the City of Springfield, Oregon.

The City of Springfield reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive minor irregularities not affecting substantial rights, and to accept such bids that in the opinion of the Springfield City Council are in the best interest of the City of Springfield.

Detailed information including bid forms may be obtained at the Engineering Division of the City of Springfield. Bids will be accepted and awarded in accordance with the City of Springfield's document on general conditions and standard specifications for public works construction.
