

King Center unveilsplaque

King Neighborhood Facility, on May 14th, unveils a plaque commemorating its namesake, the late civil rights leader, Martin Luther King, Jr.

The 10 a.m. ceremony at 4815 N.E. 7th Ave., will have Portland Mayor Frank Ivancie and Matthew Prophet, superintendent of the Portland School District, as featured speakers.

Portland City Commissioners, Charles Jordan and Margaret Strachan, will be assisted in the unveiling by two students from adjoining King Primary School and the plaque designer, artist Barbara Johnson.

The school, an early childhood education center for preschool to Grade 5, also will provide music selections from its student choir introduced by school board member Herb Cawthorne.

The facility, opened in 1975, was built by the city with funds from a federal grant and is administered as a community center by the school

The school, formerly called Highland, was renamed for the Rev. King in 1968.
