Work will be performed at Columbia Villa, a 478 unit housing complex on approximately 65 acres, located at 8920 N. Woolsey Ave., Portland, OR.

Briefly, the work will include the demolition of inner court sidewalk system and installation of approximately 110,000 sq. ft. of new concrete sidewalks; installation of inner courtyard lighting including underground electric service; construction of on-site playgrounds including equipment and landscaping; removal of existing garbage cart enclosures; construction of concrete masonry garbage structures; and site directional street signs.

President of the Urban League, testified that the plan does not serve those who need the help the most, many of the current services proposed were duplicating those already rendered by other community-based organizations and that the current plan was drafted with very little community input.

Jordan said the City should give PIC a chance. "We are giving you a chance to perform."

The City Council will monitor PIC's performance and PIC stated they would be cooperative.
