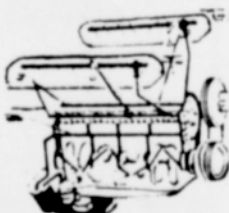

Salmon wars continue

communities like The Dalles where just 15 years ago, Indians were barred from swimming pools and restaurants.

The government is also using what Sohappay calls double jeopardy—as soon as a trial is over in one jurisdiction, it is shifted to another, which overlaps, and begun again. Schwartz calls it, "use of the judicial system to destroy a culture."

So far, the defense has kept the Indians out of jail by dragging the cases out as long as possible, the strategy being to "bankrupt the system and wear them out," said

Schwartz. He says that so far, it has worked. "We're kicking their asses" in court, he said.

Schwartz says that when the tremendous power of an insensitive white-dominated bureaucracy, including the courts, is directed against the Indians, it adds up to ethnocide—the destruction of a people and their way of life. "To a white fisherman," he said, it's selling salmon at \$12 a pound. For an Indian, it's religion, it's culture, it's everything to these Indians in this area for the last 10,000 years."

Next: "The salmon will return to us a 1000 times."
