

## Spinach pie makes a tasty brunch break

This weekend, take a leisurely brunch break from lawn and garden chores. But keep it easy for the cooking/gardening team...serve a Sunny Spinach Pie. Bake the bacon, egg, spinach, cottage cheese and pasteurized process cheese spread filling in your own flaky crust...or to keep preparation time to a minimum, bake it in a ready-to-use pie shell. Serve with fresh sliced fruits and your favorite beverage.

### SUNNY SPINACH PIE

Pastry for 1-crust 9-inch pie  
2½ quarts fresh spinach, torn, cooked, well drained  
¼ lb. pasteurized process cheese spread, cubed  
4 eggs, beaten  
4 crisply cooked bacon slices, crumbled

¼ cup cottage cheese  
¼ cup chopped onion  
¼ teaspoon pepper

On lightly floured surface, roll pastry to 12-inch circle. Place in a 9-inch pie plate. Turn under edge; flute. Prick bottom and sides with fork. Bake at 350°, 10 minutes. Combine remaining ingredients; mix well. Pour into shell; continue baking 35 minutes or until set. Top with additional process cheese spread, sliced. Let stand 10 minutes before serving.

## County fair will collect infant car seats

Multnomah County's Community Health Council has hit upon a novel way of increasing the availability of children's car seats for lower-income families.

Using the Multnomah County Fair—and it's theme of "A Family A-Fair"—as the focal point of its promotion, the Community Health Council has arranged for free admission to the Fair for anyone bringing a car seat and donating it to the County's loan program.

For more than three years, the County has been conducting this child car-seat restraint loan program, lending the seats to low-income families with small children. Noting the success of this and similar programs in reducing the incidence of death and injury to youngsters, the Legislature passed the Child Restraint Law, making child-seat restraint use mandatory for passengers under five years of age.

That recently enacted law placed additional demands on the County's program and created long waiting lists for seats until the Community Health Council came to the rescue.

The Council's promotion of both the Fair and the loan program is aimed at families whose children have outgrown the need for the restraints. Persons bringing their used seats to the Fair gates will be admitted free and can leave the seats at a special booth inside the main building. The booth will be staffed from noon through 8 p.m. each day of the Fair, which runs from July 24 - 29 at the Expo Center in North Portland at Marine Drive.

The car seats will be cleaned and repaired before being turned over to the loan program. Donations of either car seats or cash to the program are tax deductible.
