Community teams qualify for Olympics

Two basketball teams from the Matt Dishman Community Center, have qualified for the national A.A.U. Jr. Olympics, which are to be held in Frankfort, Kentucky (Aug. 2-5) for the 5th graders and in Jacksonville, Florida (Aug. 13-19) for the 7th graders.

Both teams have placed first in the State A.A.U. Jr. Olympics and the 5th-grade team took first in the N.W. Regional Zone Championships while the 7th-grade team took second place. By taking both first

place and second place in the A.A.U. Regionals, the boys now have the opportunity to participate on the National level.

Hood Community College on July 1, 1984. This earned him a trip to the National TAC meet which was held at Louisiana State University in Baton Rouge, LA, during the week of July 19th thru 22nd.

Over 1,000 young men and women, nation wide, between the ages of 16 thru 18 were competing in the TAC Junior Olympics. Of the 29 finalists in the shot put, Matt finished 17th, even though his competitors were mostly 18- and 19-year olds. Jantzen tennis tournament set

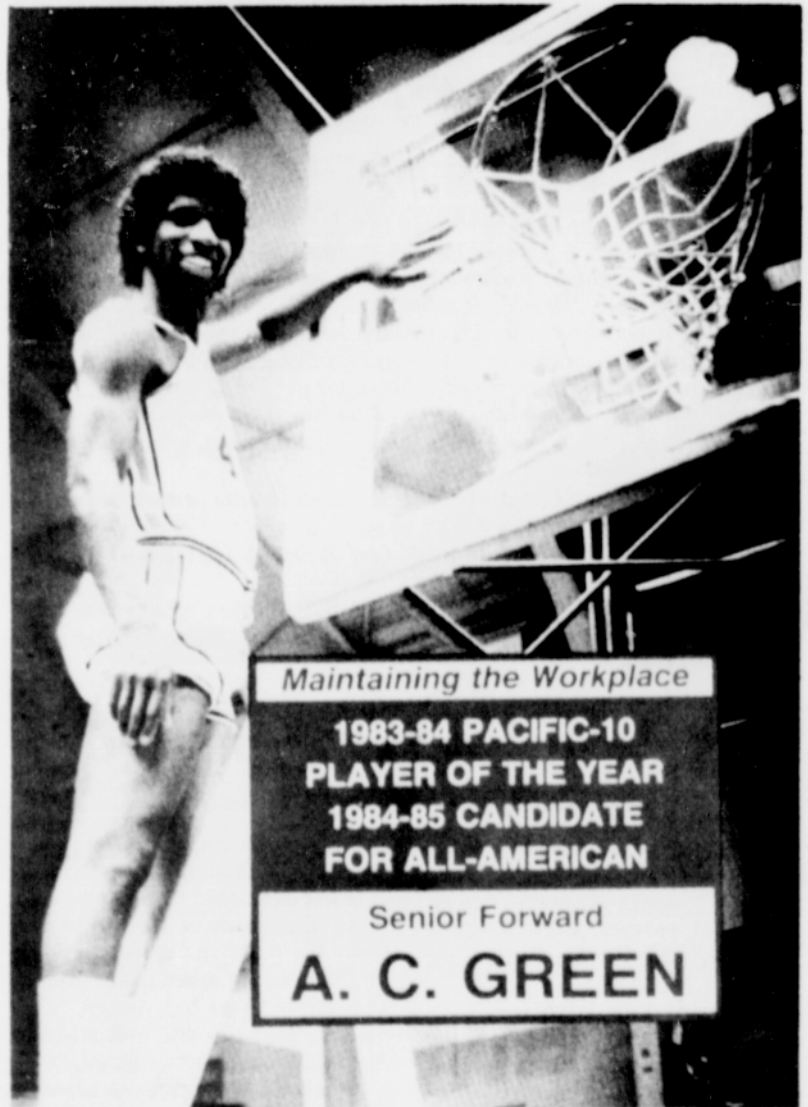
Brian Joelson of Portland, a Texas A&M alumnus, has won all three previous Oregon Clay Courts titles. His 12th straight singles victory in the 1983 title match was a 7-5, 6-4 victory over Rick Bengtson of Vancouver, B.C. Joelson and his challengers begin play in a round of 16 at 11:00 a.m. Thursday, August 9, at the picturesque Eastmoreland Club, 3015 S.E. Berkley Way. Quarterfinals are Friday at 3:00 p.m., semi-finals, Saturday at noon,

and the championship match Sunday at 1:00 p.m.

Daily tickets are \$3.00 for adults and \$1.50 for children 16 and younger and may be obtained at the club.

Jantzen is providing \$1,400 in prize money this year, with \$500 to the winner, \$300 to the runner-up, and \$150 each to the losing semi-finalists. The additional funds will go to the winner and runner-up of a doubles tournament, which will be played concurrently.

A.C. Green: The Beavers' lone senior in 1984-85 had a junior season that should more than qualify him for All-American consideration this season. The 6-9, 220-pound Green was the Pacific-10 Conference Player of the Year and received honorable mention on most All-American lists. A member of the Olympic trials, Green was the nation's fourth best marksmen from the field at .667 (134-204). The only players who bettered that mark for accuracy were Houston's Akeem Olajuwon, Alabama's Bobby Lee Hurt and Georgetown's Patrick Ewing.
