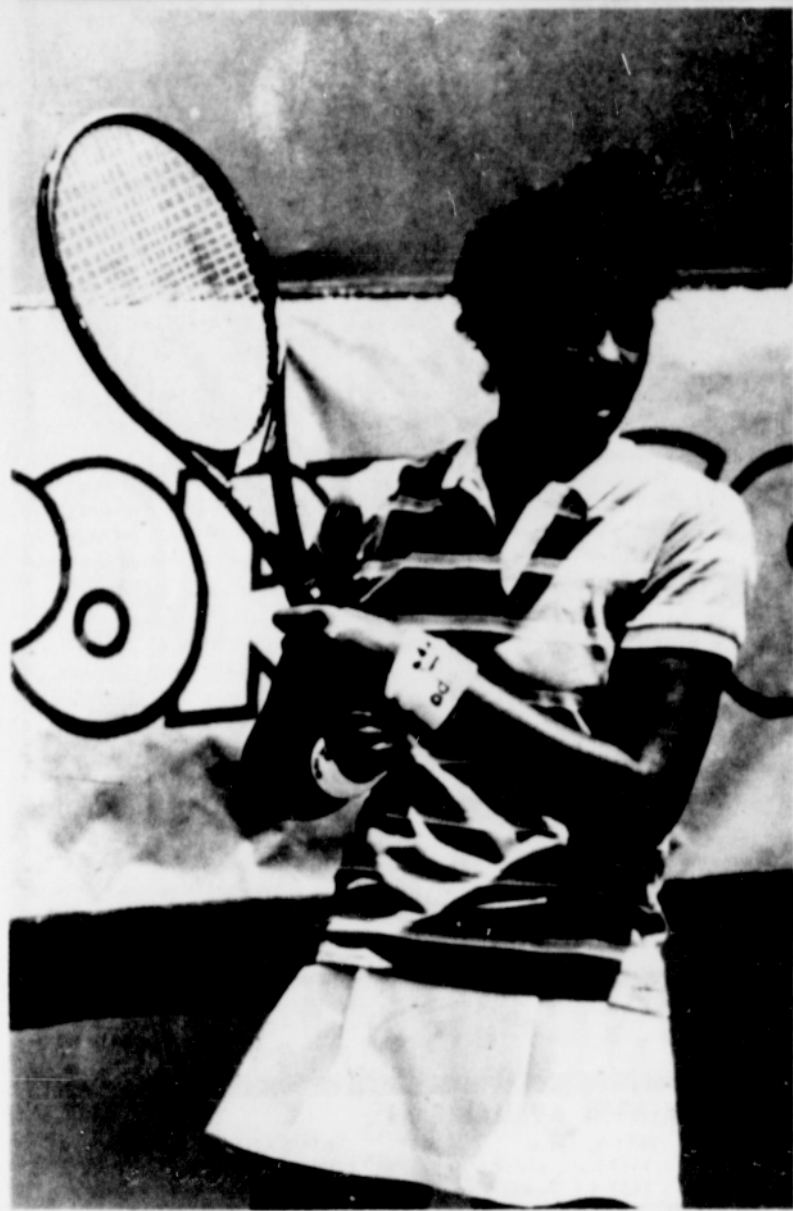




Sports Briefs

Youth tennis meet set for Anaheim

USTA/Sport Goofy national titlist Iwalani McCalla of Los Altos, Calif., is among 128 junior tennis players from 45 countries who will be competing in The Sport Goofy Trophy, the International Tennis Federation world championships for players 14-and-under and 12-and-under, Sept. 19-23 at the Walt Disney World resort complex.

The tournament climaxes a summer-long series of qualifying events involving approximately 300,000 junior tennis players in more than 70 countries world-wide. The Trophy series is the only such world-wide elimination tournament for juniors sanctioned by the International Tennis Federation (ITF).

Iwalani qualified for the world tournament by winning the 14-and-under girls championship at the USTA/Sport Goofy Nationals, in August at Anaheim, Calif. The other U.S. national champions are: Andre Agassi of Las Vegas, Nev. (14-and-under boys); Michael Chang of La Costa, Calif. (12-and-under boys); and Laxmi Poruri of Upland, Calif. (12-and-under girls).

A total of 16 players (the four semifinalists in each division) advanced from the USTA/Sport Goofy Nationals to the world event. Other participants are the champions and high finishers from continental tournaments in Asia, Europe and South America, and from national competitions in other regions.

The inaugural Sport Goofy Trophy world championships, in 1983, were dominated by U.S. players, who captured three of the

four division titles: Jared Palmer of Largo, Fla., won the boys 12; Noelle Porter of San Juan Capistrano, Calif., won the girls 12; and Susan Sloane of Lexington, Ky., won the girls 14. The boys 14 title was won by Mexico's Eduardo Velez.

The trophy series has grown out of Walt Disney Productions' involvement with European youth tennis, dating back more than a decade. Such successful players as Bjorn Borg, Stefan Edberg (Olympic men's champion), Steffi Graf (Olympic women's champion) and Mats Wilander participated in Disney tennis before their pro careers.

In launching the trophy, ITF President Philippe Chatrier observed, "In our opinion, it is during these years of youth that true tennis talent is first nurtured, and we now have achieved a tangible means by which youngsters are attracted and encouraged to play tennis."

Through the comical Disney character, the youthful participants are encouraged to demonstrate good sportsmanship and to compete "for fun." Tournament week at the world famous Central Florida vacation destination combines championship tennis with unique Disney entertainment experiences in the Magic Kingdom and Epcot Center.

The popularity of the concept has attracted major corporate participation from Adidas, Coca-Cola and Eastern Airlines.
