NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Clackamas County, through its Community Development Division, will receive sealed bids for the construction of Country Club Water District Water System Improvements for the Country Club Water District until 3:00 p.m., October 12, 1984. Bids shall be publicly opened and read aloud in the main conference room, Community Development Division, O'Hara Hall, Maryhurst College, Maryhurst, Oregon. No bids will be received or considered after that time. This project requires prequalification of bidders as described in the "Instruction to Bidders".

This project is financed through the Community Development Block Grant Program with funds obtained from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. The contract will be subject to regulations of the Departments of Labor and Housing and Urban Development.

The project pertains to the construction of the following:

SCHEDULE "W"

Construction of a well house and installation of a well pump and piping in an existing 6-inch well casing, includes mechanical, electrical and pump controls.

SCHEDULE "R"

Construction of a 30,000 Gallon Ground Water Storage Reservoir of either welded mild steel, bolted fused glass, epoxy, or polymer steel or cast-in-place concrete.

SCHEDULE "T"

Construction of a 6-inch PVC Water Transmission Pipeline, approximately 1500 lineal feet in length. Included also is reconnection of existing house services.

Bidders may bid on any one, all, or any combination of the Schedules. Clackamas County reserves the right to award separate contracts for each Schedule or any combination of Schedules.

Copies may be obtained by prospective bidders upon receipt of a refundable deposit in the amount of \$25.00 made payable to the engineer.

No bid will be considered unless fully completed in the manner provided in the "Instructions to Bidders", upon the bid form provided by the engineer and accompanied by a 10% bid security executed in favor of Clackamas County, as more fully detailed in the "Instruction to Bidders". Attention is called to ORS Chapter 279 and State and Federal provisions for equal employment opportunity, affirmative action, HUD Section 3 Requirements and Minimum Salaries and Wage Rates.

Bidders must be prequalified to bid on this project. Bidders not currently prequalified by Clackamas County or Oregon State Department of Transportation may apply for prequalification no later than ten (10) days prior to the bid opening on forms available from the county or engineer.

Materials supplied under this contract must be as specified or equal. In all cases equivalency must be established ten (10) days in advance of the date of bid upon written approval by the engineer.

The Clackamas County Board of County Commissioners reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive all informalities.
