INVITATION TO BID WILLAMETTE INTERCEPTOR 1B

Sealed bids for the construction of the Willamette Interceptor 1B will be received by the Owner, Tri-City Service District, by the Department of Environmental Services, 902 Abernethy Road, Oregon City, Oregon 97045, until 2:00 p.m. on November 13, 1984. As soon thereafter as possible, the bids will be opened publicly and read aloud. Bids shall be addressed to the Department of Environmental Services, 902 Abernethy Road, Oregon City, Oregon 97045, and shall be labeled "Bids for Willamette Interceptor 1B".

The work includes the furnishing of labor, materials and equipment to construct the Willamette Interceptor 1B and related work.

The contract will be awarded on the basis of a single, total price. Contract award will be based on a least cost in a responsive and responsible manner to the Owner.

The gravity sewer portion of the project consists of approximately 3,290 lineal feet of 54-inch reinforced concrete pipe (RCP), 40 lineal feet of 48-inch RCP, 1,200 lineal feet of 45-inch concrete cylinder pipe or cement mortar lined and coated steel pipe (CCP), 475 lineal feet of 45-inch RCP or CCP, 85 lineal feet of 36-inch RCP, 235 lineal feet of 33-inch CCP, 365 lineal feet of 30-inch CCP and 22 lineal feet of 12-inch RCP. Appurtenances include manholes, approximately 180 lineal feet of tunneled or bored and jacked casing pipe and grouted in 54-inch carrier pipe, and poured-in-place concrete support piers. Related work includes removal of 1,440 lineal feet of 20-inch and 270 lineal feet of 18-inch above ground steel pipe, removal and disposal of 560 lineal feet of 21-inch concrete pipe of which 120 lineal feet, more or less is concrete encased, the removal and disposal of 12 poured-in-place concrete manholes, and modification of existing concrete piers for pipe supports.

Copies of the plans and specifications may be obtained at 902 Abernethy Road, Oregon City, Oregon 97045, upon payment of \$30 for each set. Payments for plans and specifications will not be refunded.

Each bid shall be accompanied by a bid guaranty bond, or a certified or cashier's check payable to the order of the Owner in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the amount of the bid as a guaranty that the bidder will execute the contract if it be awarded in conformity with the bid form. The successful bidder will be required to furnish performance and payment bonds, each in an amount not less than one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to determine which bid is, in the Owner's judgment, the lowest responsive bid of a bidder or group of bidders. The Owner also reserves the right to waive any informalities in any bid and to delete certain items listed in the bid as set forth therein.

Bids received after the time established for receiving bids will not be considered. No bidder may withdraw his bid after the time established for receiving bids or before the award and execution of the contract, unless the award is delayed for a period exceeding ninety (90) calendar days.

Applications have been made to the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) for the financial assistance in the work proposed under this invitation to bid. EPA, in implementation of Executive Order No. 11246 (Equal Employment Opportunity), as amended, requires its constituent offices which provide financial assistance for construction, to conduct a prebid conference regarding Bid Conditions, Affirmative Action Requirements, and Equal Employment Opportunity.

Any contract or contracts awarded under this Invitation to Bid are expected to be funded in part by a grant from EPA. Neither the United States nor any part of its departments, agencies, or employees is, or will be, a party to this Invitation to Bid or any resulting contract. This procurement will be subject to regulations contained in 40 CFR Part 33.
