The University of Tennessee at Chattanooga invites applications and nominations for the position of Provost.

POSITION DESCRIPTION

The Provost is the chief academic officer of The University of Tennessee at Chattanooga, a vital urban institution serving area needs with high quality undergraduate education complemented by programs of graduate study, research, and public service. The University currently has an enrollment of 7,500, with 1,310 graduate students, 293 full-time faculty, an annual budget of almost \$40 million and a private endowment currently valued in excess of \$20 million. The Provost reports directly to the Chancellor and is responsible for all academic programs and most academic services at the University. Reporting to the Provost are Associate Provosts for Graduate and Continuing Studies and for Academic Services, an Assistant Provost for Institutional Research and Planning, the Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences, and Deans of the Schools of Business Administration, Education, Engineering, Human Services, and Nursing.

QUALIFICATIONS

The candidate should possess an earned doctorate or an equivalent terminal degree in a recognized academic discipline, a proven record of academic administrative accomplishment in higher education, and credentials consistent with those of a senior faculty member. A strong commitment to excellence in teaching, research and creative activities, and public service is expected. Applications are particularly solicited from women and members of minority groups.
