In addition to providing diversified counseling to individuals, families, churches, agencies and service-based groups, it also provides emergency food,

clothing, shelter and homes for delinquent teens as well as adoption services. Its philosophy is, if families are whole, then the communities are healthier and the quality of life is better.

Joshua and Virginia were selected and honored by KOIN-TV as Heros in 1984, and the Honor is well deserved, they've helped a lot of families in distress. Maranatha Church is located at 4222 NE 12th. Admission is free. However, donations will be accepted in an effort to raise \$30,000.
