### INVITATION TO BID

Sealed proposals for the Elm Street L.I.D. will be received at the office of the City Recorder of the City of Forest Grove, 1924 Council Street, P.O. Box 326, Forest Grove, Oregon 97116, until 2:00 p.m. local time the 21st day of February, 1985, and then publicly opened and read.

The work consists of:

Reconstruction of Elm Street between 15th Avenue and 19th Avenue including: 1850 linear feet of 40 foot wide paved roadway with asphaltic concrete or Portland Cement Concrete, curb and gutter, sidewalks, 240 linear feet of 10' storm pipe, and landscaping (57 trees).

Plans and specifications may be examined at the office of the Department of Community Development, City of Forest Grove Administrative Building, 1924 Council Street, P. O. Box 326, Forest Grove, Oregon 97116. A copy of said documents may be obtained at the office of the Department of Community Development upon payment of a \$25.00 non-refundable fee.

Each proposal must be submitted on the prescribed form and accompanied by a certified check of bid bond payable to the City of Forest Grove, in an amount not less than ten percent (10%) of the amount bid. No bids will be received or considered unless the proposal is properly completed and signed.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish a Performance and Payment Bond for faithful performance of the Contract in the full amount of the Contract price.

This project is partially financed through the Community Development Block Grant Jobs Bill Appropriation with funds obtained from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development. The contract will be subject to regulations of the Departments of Labor and Housing and Urban Development.

The successful bidder shall comply with ORS Chapter 279, State or Federal provisions for Equal Employment Opportunity, Affirmative Action HUD Section 3 requirements, and the minimum salaries and wages as set forth in the Contract Documents.

This contract will be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder for the selected alternate. The City reserves the right to select either the concrete or asphalt alternate, independent of price, for award of contract. The City of Forest Grove reserves the right to reject any or all proposals. The City of Forest Grove reserves the right to postpone award of the Contract for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days from the date of bid opening for the purpose of reviewing the bids, and to accept that proposal which is to the best interest of the City of Forest Grove.

Bidders who are in doubt as to their qualifications are encouraged to contact the City Engineer informally to determine if a prequalification request is necessary. Prequalification requests must be submitted no later than ten (10) days prior to the bid opening date.
