Sealed bids will be received at the office of the City recorder, Room 205, City Hall, Salem, Oregon, until but not after 11:00 a.m., Local Time on February 20, 1985 at which time all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at the Council Chambers, Civic Center, 555 Liberty Street SE, Salem, Oregon 97301, for THE CONSTRUCTION OF OFF-SITE UTILITY IMPROVEMENTS FOR CEDD AREA.

The proposed work consists of: Water System Improvements (Contract I) including some 4910 lineal feet of 24-inch D.I., watedine and miscellaneous appurtenances, cleanup, testing and restoration complete. Sewer Force Main (Contract II) including some 5430 lineal feet of dual 12-inch P.V.C. force main and miscellaneous appurtenances, cleanup, testing and restoration complete. Sewage Pump Station (Contract III) including a cast in place concrete structure, mechanical, electrical and telemetry controls, and miscellaneous appurtenances.

Plans, specifications and other bid documents may be inspected and obtained upon payment of a non-refundable deposit of \$25.00, at the office of the City of Salem, Department of Public Works, 555 Liberty Street S.E., Room 325, Salem, Oregon 97301. The bidder shall not file the book of "Standard Construction Specifications" with his bid.

Bids shall be made on the forms furnished by the City, addressed, and mailed or delivered to the City Recorder, Room 205, City Hall, Salem, Oregon, in a sealed envelope plainly marked "BID ON CONSTRUCTION OF OFF-SITE UTILITY IMPROVEMENTS FOR CEDD AREA" and the name and address of the bidder.

A surety bond, cashier's check or certified check of the bidder, made payable to the City of Salem, in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the bid must accompany each bid as security. Bid security of all save the three lowest bidders will be returned following the bid opening; all bid security will be refunded upon execution of the contract by the successful bidder.

No bid will be received or considered by the City of Salem unless the bid contains a statement by the bidder that the provisions of ORS 279.350 shall be included in his contract.

Contractor's Prequalification Applications must be submitted to the City Purchasing Supervisor (1340 20th Street S.E., Salem, Oregon 97302) for approval, on or before February 12, 1985 which is at least five working days prior to the scheduled bid opening date. Upon approval, the bidder will receive a valid proposal for bidding purposes.

No bid shall be received or considered from any bidder who does not have an approved prequalification application on file with the City Purchasing Supervisor.
