OBITUARY: Ronnie Williams

Ronnie Williams died Friday, January 25, 1985, of heart failure. Ronnie was born in Birmingham, Alabama, in 1946. He was a leader in the Alabama Black Panther Movement, which organized community self-defense against Klan violence, a breakfast for children program, and distributed the Black Panther newspaper. In 1973 he came to Oregon, fleeing the Alabama "justice system" which was attempting to eliminate all leaders of the Alabama Black Liberation Front. Ronnie was wounded in a "shoot-in" where 35 deputies had surrounded a house subjecting the occupants to a two-minute barrage of fire. He then was convicted of assaulting a police officer by an all-white jury, although not one shot had been fired from within the house the police had surrounded. He won his extradition hearing in Oregon when Governor McCall refused to extradite Ronnie back to Alabama.

For 13 years Ronnie lived in Portland where he continued working in the community here. He is survived by his daughter Jacqueline Williams. A book of his poetry will be forthcoming. Ronnie was an inspiration and continues to be and that is why a memorial gathering is being held. All friends in the community who are seeking peace as Ronnie did are welcome.

The memorial will be held on Friday, February 1, at King Center Auditorium, 4850 NE 7th at 6 p.m. Funds to help transport his family to the funeral in Alabama will be accepted at the memorial. Any excess funds will go toward the Free South Africa fund.
