INVITATION FOR BIDS

(Plumbing)

Sealed bids for the installation of a new domestic hot water system for a 75-unit, 5-story building will be received by the Housing Authority of Portland (HAP) at 8910 N. Woolsey Avenue, Portland, Oregon 97203 until 3:00 p.m., PST, Tuesday, February 19, 1985 and, following a short interval, publicly opened and read aloud. Bidders may be present for the opening and reading of the bids.

Basically, the work will consist of the removal of an existing domestic hot water system that utilizes steam and converting to a gas fired high recovery system. The project location is in the basement of the Rosenbaum Plaza located at 1218 SW Washington, Portland, Oregon.

Prospective bidders may obtain one set of bidding documents at the HAP Office between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. upon deposit of \$20 which will be refunded upon return of undamaged documents within ten days after bid opening. Additional sets of documents may be procured for \$15 per set which is NOT refundable.

Attention is called to the following:

1. Provisions for equal employment opportunity and payment of not less than the minimum salaries and wages as set forth in the specifications must be paid on this project.
2. The Housing Authority of Portland reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informalities in the bidding.
3. No bid shall be withdrawn for a period of 90 days subsequent to the opening of bids without the consent of the Housing Authority of Portland.
