NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Sealed bids for the construction of The Water Treatment Plan Renovation and Raw Water Intake for the City of Amity, Yamhill County, Oregon will be received at 2:30 p.m., on March 7, 1985. Bids submitted prior to the opening are to be delivered to the City Recorder's Office, City Hall, Amity, Oregon. The bid opening will be conducted in the Council Chamber at the Amity City Hall. All bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The project consists of the following bid schedules:

One copy may be obtained by pre-qualified prospective bidders upon receipt of cash or check in the amount of \$50.00 made payable to the Engineer. Deposits will be refundable upon their return in good condition.

Bidders must pre-qualify with Owner, via Engineer, on Standard Oregon Review Board of APWA Prequalification Forms, ten days prior to bid opening. If a prequalification form is on file with the Engineer and is not over one year old, re-filing is not necessary.

The Bidder's attention is called to the "Equal Opportunity Clause," the "Standard Federal Equal Employment Opportunity Construction Contract Specifications," and "Section 3" Requirements.

This project is being financed by a grant from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.

Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Bond executed in favor of the City of Amity in an amount of ten percent of the total amount of the bid.

The City of Amity reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive all informalities. No bidder may withdraw or modify their bid after the hour set for the opening and thereafter until the lapse of sixty days.

Bids must be on the bid form provided to prospective bidders and, when Bid Surety is required, must be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check drawn on a United States bank or a bid bond payable to the Port of Portland in an amount equal to at least 10 percent of the total amount bid.

When prequalification is required, the prequalification statements should be received at least 10 days prior to the time set for bid opening. Applications for prequalification may be submitted less than 10 days before bid opening, but consideration by the Port cannot be assured.

Attention is called to the provisions of the Oregon Revised Statutes 279.350, providing that workers be paid prevailing wage rates.
