Bids will be publicly opened and read immediately following in the City Council Chambers. The City of Spokane ensures that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, sex or national origin in consideration for an award. Minority hirings are provided for in contract specifications.

Bids for this project are invited from minority group contractors who have been prequalified; however, all prequalified firms may compete.

Bids shall be submitted on unit price basis on the forms provided, in accordance with the provisions of the specifications; no bids containing unrealistic bid prices will be accepted. Bids are to be filed in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the City of Spokane, and shall be addressed to the City Clerk.

A certified check or surety bond in the sum of 5% of the Total Amount of Bid must accompany the copy of the bid filed with the City Clerk.

No bidder may withdraw his bid after the time set for the opening thereof, unless the award of contract is delayed for a period exceeding sixty (60) days.

Successful bidder shall execute the contract within ten (10) days after the date of award.

The City Council reserves the right to reject any or all bids submitted.
