

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed proposals for the CITY WELL NO. 5 - Phase 2 (Community Development Block Grant Project No. 4050) within the City of Sherwood, Oregon, will be received at the City of Sherwood Senior Center, 855 N. Sherwood Boulevard, Sherwood, Oregon 97140, until 10:00 A.M., on the 29th day of March, 1985, and then will be publicly opened and read aloud.

Work consists of site grading and paving, well building construction, and pump, motor and control installation for an existing 16-inch diameter, 700 GMP water well. All work shall be completed within ninety (90) calendar days of Award of Contract.

Plans and specifications may be obtained at the City of Sherwood, 90 N.W. Park Street, Sherwood, Oregon 97140 after payment of a non-refundable deposit of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00).

Each proposal must be submitted on the prescribed form and accompanied by a certified check or bid bond payable to the City of Sherwood, in an amount not less than ten percent (10%) of the amount bid.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish a Performance and Payment Bond for faithful performance of the Contract in the full amount of the Contract price.

The Contract will be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder; the City of Sherwood reserves the right to reject any or all proposals. The City of Sherwood also reserves the right to postpone award of the Contract for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days from date of bid opening for the purpose of reviewing the bids, and to accept that proposal which is to the best interests of the City of Sherwood.

The project is financed through the Community Development Block Grant Program with funds obtained from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. The Contract will be subject to regulations of the Department of Labor and Housing and Urban Development.

Attention is called to ORS Chapter 279 and State and Federal provisions for Equal Employment Opportunity, Affirmative Action, HUD Section 8 requirements, and the minimum salaries and wages as set forth in the Contract Documents.
