The City Clerk will receive sealed bids until 9:30 a.m., March 14, 1985, for the above project located in Spokane, Washington, in accordance with plans and specifications on file in the office of the Public Works Director, Skywalk Level, Municipal Building, West 080 Spokane Falls Boulevard, Spokane, WA 99201-3343; telephone (509) 456-4300. The bids will be publicly opened and read immediately following in the City Council Chambers. Copies of Plans and Specifications are available at the Public Works Department, upon payment of fifty dollars (\$50.00).

The City of Spokane ensures that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, sex or national origin in consideration for an award. Minority hirings are provided for in contract specifications.

Bids for this project are invited from minority group contractors who have been prequalified; however, all prequalified firms may compete.

Bids shall be submitted on unit price basis on the forms provided, in accordance with the provisions of the specifications; no bids containing unrealistic bid prices will be accepted. Bids are to be filed in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the City of Spokane, and shall be addressed to the City Clerk.

A certified check or surety bond in the sum of 5% of the Total Amount of Bid must accompany the copy of the bid filed with the City Clerk.

No bidder may withdraw his bid after the time set for the opening thereof, unless the award of contract is delayed for a period exceeding sixty (60) days.

Successful bidder shall execute the contract within ten (10) days after the date of award.

The City Council reserves the right to reject any or all bids submitted.

INVITATION TO BID FOR THE REHABILITATION OF AN 8-INCH SEWER MAIN IN MILLER STREET AND OWENS STREET, FAIRMOUNT AVENUE TO WEST OF SAGINAW

Sealed bids will be received at the office of the City Recorder, City Hall, Room 205, Salem, Oregon, until but not after 11:00 a.m., Local Time on March 27, 1985, at which time all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at the Council Chambers, Civic Center, 555 Liberty Street S.E., Salem, Oregon for the "REHABILITATION OF AN 8-INCH SEWER MAIN IN MILLER STREET AND OWENS STREET, FAIRMOUNT AVENUE TO WEST OF SAGINAW STREET."

The proposed work consists of: 975 lineal feet of 8-inch sewer pipe, four manholes and appurtenant work.

Plans, specifications and other bid documents may be inspected and obtained at the office of the City of Salem, Department of Public Works, 555 Liberty Street S.E., Room 325, Salem, Oregon. The bidder shall not file the book of "Standard Construction Specifications" with his bid.

Bids shall be made on the forms furnished by the City, addressed and mailed or delivered to the City Recorder, City Hall, Room 205, Salem, Oregon 97301, in a sealed envelope plainly marked "Bid on Miller Street and Owens Street Sewer," and the name and address of the bidder.

A surety bond, cashier's check or certified check of the bidder, made payable to the City of Salem, in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the bid must accompany each bid as security. Bid security of all save the three lowest bidders will be returned following the bid opening; all bid security will be refunded upon execution of the contract by the successful bidder.

No bid will be received or considered by the City of Salem unless the bid contains a statement by the bidder the provisions of ORS 279.350 shall be included in his contract.

Contractors' Prequalification Applications must be submitted to the City Purchasing Supervisor (1340 20th Street S.E., Salem, OR 97302) for approval, on or before March 19, 1985, which is at least five working days prior to the scheduled bid opening date. Upon approval the bidder will receive a valid proposal for bidding purposes.

No bid shall be received or considered from any bidder who does not have an approved prequalification application on file with the City Purchasing Supervisor.
